- We are also grateful for your prayers and support for the ongoing construction. We are now
  building a multipurpose hall that can accommodate about 300-500, a mini conference room,
  guest room etc. It has not been an easy journey. The challenge is not just the finance but
  dealing with the contractor and workers is a big hiccup. As each of you have faithfully been
  doing, please continue to pray for timely completion of the work and so much patience,
  ideas and wisdom as we carry on with the work.
- We are also delighted to share with you that with the generous support of RFI we were able to buy a winger (13+1 seater) for staff daily transportation. This has been a big need since we relocated to Seluophe and we are so very grateful to God for providing this need through RFI.
- We also built a small wooden house to run a simple decent tea stall, provide treading and Xerox services. We are still working on it and we would so appreciate your ideas, prayers and visits.

We are also very proud to share with you about Ellen who courageously shared her story of how God freed her from drugs, alcohol and the wrong things she was into. She shared her story during the program held on 26<sup>th</sup> June in commemoration of World Day against drug abuse and illicit trafficking. She also mesmerized the crowd with a beautiful harmonica piece "Count your Blessings". As you listen to the piece, may it be music to your ears, a melody to your heart and may your soul be enriched.
